

A vision of the Mother of God. In the midst of a great brilliance, I saw the Mother of God clothed in a white gown, girt about with a golden cincture; and there were tiny stars, also of gold, over the whole garment, and

chevron-shaped sleeves lined with gold. Her cloak was sky-blue, lightly thrown over the shoulders. A transparent veil was delicately drawn over her head, while her flowing hair was set off beautifully by a golden crown that terminated in little crosses. On her left arm she held the Child Jesus. A Blessed Mother of this type I had not yet seen. Then she looked at me kindly and said: "I am the Mother of God of Priests." At that she lowered Jesus from her arm to the ground, raised her right hand heavenward and said; "O God, bless Poland, bless priests." Then she addressed me once again: "Tell the priests what you have seen." I resolved that at the first opportunity [I would have] of seeing Father [Andrasz] I would tell; but I myself can make nothing of this vision. (Diary 1585)

My Response: Father in heaven, bless all priests and those discerning a vocation to the priesthood. Grant them the grace to be guided by our most beautiful heavenly mother, Mary.

Steeple Chase Roof Repair

Rain drops are falling here again at Blessed Sacrament Parish. Many of you are aware of the fact that we have had countless, major leaks in our roofs among the many buildings of our campus. Our Sacristy and Chapel area, Parish Center and School had their roofs replaced last year thanks in part to all of you and to a generous bequest. This leaves Father Cotter Hall and the Steeple Section of the Church.

This is where you, as parishioners and friends of Blessed Sacrament, come in to play. We have begun another MAJOR CAPITAL CAMPAIGN with a goal of raising sufficient funds to cover the cost of the necessary roof repairs. However, we cannot accomplish this goal without your generous support. We had signed the contract for \$128,000 but it is now \$159,992 due to the fact that they found only 1.1% of asbestos which requires parts of the roof have to be abated. The steeple repair quote is \$26,000. We are calling this Campaign the **Steeple Chase Roof Repair**. We are counting on your ongoing generosity. RESPECT LIFE COMMITTEE

"The lie that children conceived in rape are not worthy of life is dehumanizing. Imagine reading article after article about how you're merely a statistic that should've been violently eliminated."

"This isn't about how great I am. I'm not. It's about how great Love is. It's about how great Truth is. Contrary to what I've been called by a pro-abortion politician, I'm not the residue of the rapist; I'm the resilience of my birth mom. Victims of sexual violence need authentic healing, not abortion huckstering." "Fear is bondage. Faith is freedom. We can do all things through Christ who strengthens us, even in cases of rape. I'll keep fighting for the most marginalized among the marginalized. Because that was once me."




